Dear Fellow Knitters and Crocheters,

Do you ever get overwhelmed with how many projects you want to knit? That's how I feel when we receive another book by Marianne Isager. The third book in her trilogy, My Knitting Life, Tokyo Tversted, has just arrived. She writes about her experiences traveling around the world and designing knitwear, revealing inspirations behind her designs. Isager yarns are some of our most popular. In recent years they have added several new fibers and have expanded their color selection. It's hard not to be inspired.

This winter, Nancy will be teaching a class on the Mussel Sweater, which is featured in the book. The design was inspired by a seashell she found on the beach on the Izu Peninsula (Japan). This sweater is a beautiful combination of colors and stitchwork. Penny Theo will also be teaching a class on one of Marianne's designs called Zambezi full of colorful geometric patterns. For this pattern she drew her inspiration from fabrics on display in the Museum in Harare (Zimbabwe).

I'm still feeling energized from the response to our "Evening of Knittin' Mittens". Over 40 knitters filled the shop to knit mittens for those in need. These mittens will be added to other items such as scarves and hats that we collect each year through our Giving Tree program. These items will be donated to shelters in the city. Thanks to all who participated.

During the year we accept donations from

customers who request that we wind yarn not purchased in the shop. From these funds, \$250 was donated to World Central Kitchen for help those in the southeast who experienced Hurricane Milton's wrath. Project Linus received \$200 to support their efforts in providing handmade blankets for children in hospitals. Other donations to the shop were forwarded to the Loose Ends Project, a program that links knitters and crocheters to families who wish to have a project completed that had been started by someone who is deceased or no longer able to finish the project.

We are very excited to announce we will have new neighbors this spring. The Book Bin is moving from across the street to the space formerly occupied by Leonards. (and more recently Country Classics). We think it's great!

INTRO TO RAVELRY Intimidated and confused about Ravelry? We'll demystify the process for signing up for Ravelry, finding patterns and saving your own projects for future reference. Thursday Mornings 10 a.m. -12 p.m., February 28, March 7, 14 \$95 FINISHING You probably have heard that the finishing can make or break a project. It is integral with the knitted piece. Skills being taught include seaming, picking up stitches, buttonholes, sewing in ends and more. Bring a project to finish or else samples swatches will be provided. Wednesday Afternoons, 3-5 p.m., March 5 & 12 \$65 CORRECTING MISTAKES Students need to knit two 4" swatches, one in garter and one in stockinette and leave them on the needles. Please bring a crochet hook and tapestry needle.
